

Habitat Completes Fellsmere's Grace Meadows Community

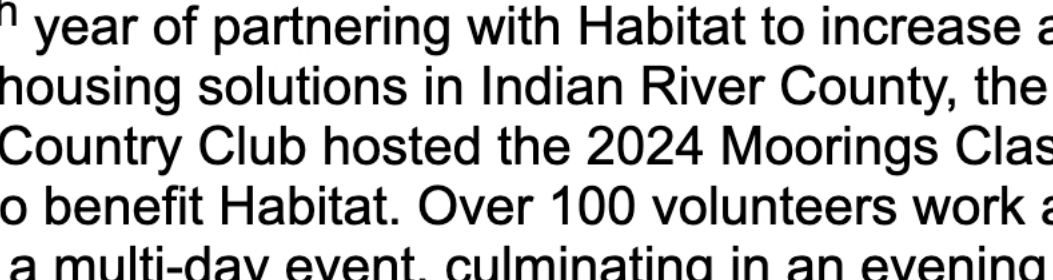


In 2008, construction began on Habitat's Fellsmere community, and now, 16 years later, 68 families call it home.

2024 Moorings Classic Weekend Raises Funds for Habitat's Mission



In their 26th year of partnering with Habitat to increase access to affordable housing solutions in Indian River County, the Moorings Yacht and Country Club hosted the 2024 Moorings Classic Weekend to benefit Habitat. Over 100 volunteers work all year to coordinate a multi-day event, culminating in an evening celebration each February.

This year's effort raised \$775,000, which will fund 6 new construction homes, at least 17 critical home repair projects, and 15 scholarships for homebuyers, and their dependents. 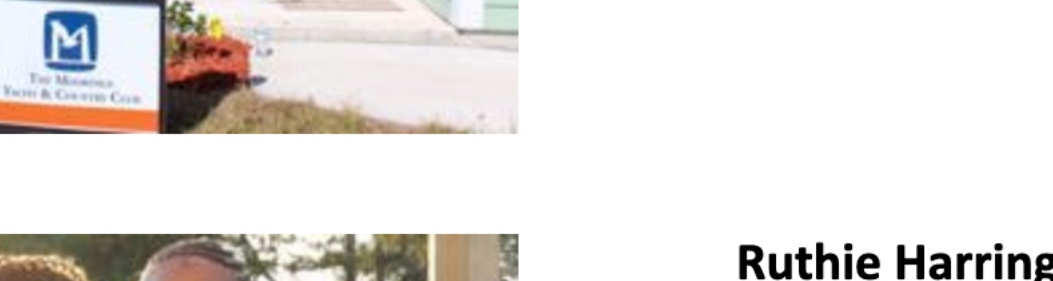
State Farm Awards Indian River Habitat with \$10,000 Grant

We were honored to attend GH COP's Grant Award Breakfast alongside other nonprofit leaders and support services within our community.

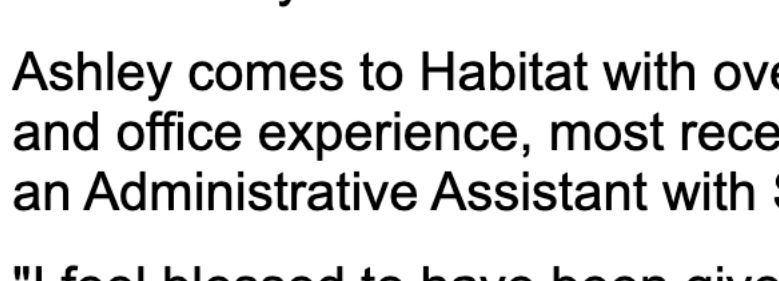

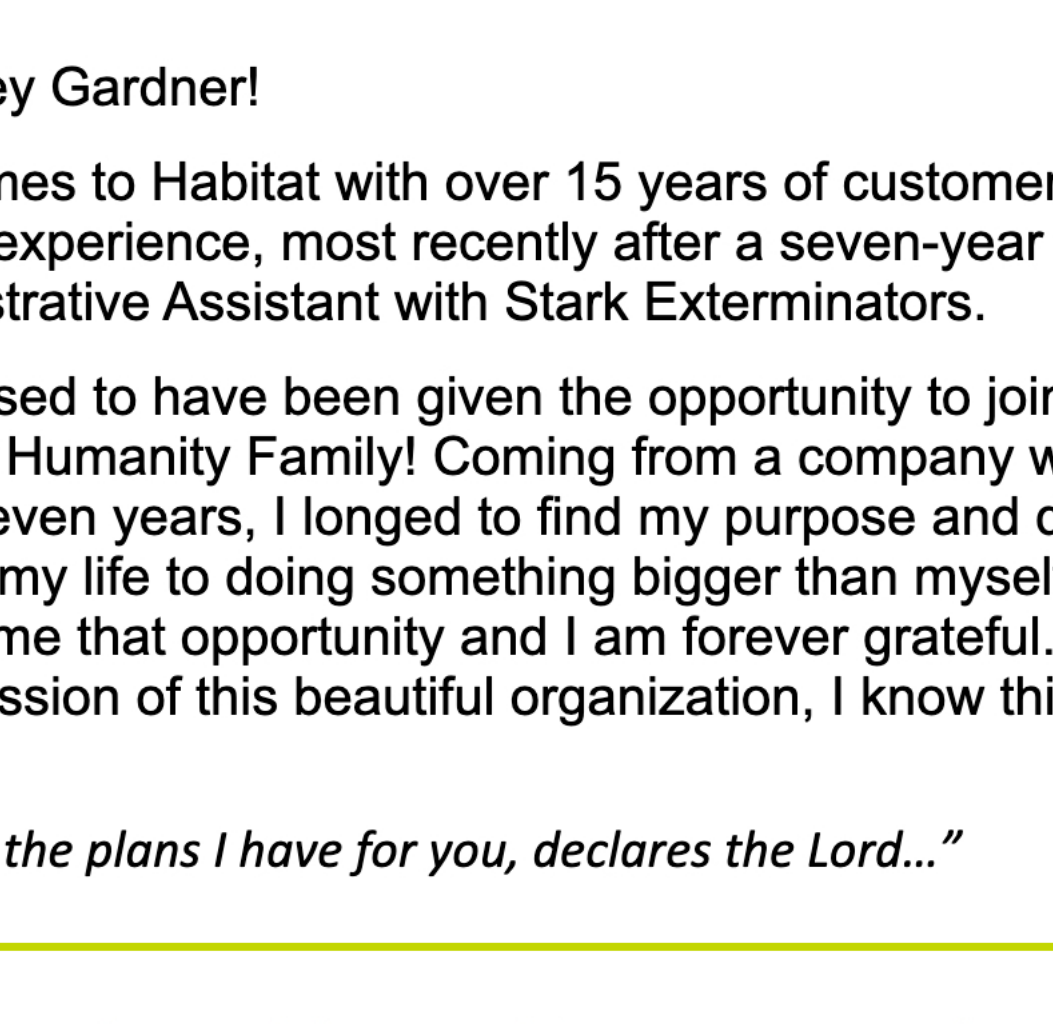
